BASIC APPRAISAL PRINCIPLES

The Northern Ohio Chapter of the Appraisal Institute presents “Basic Appraisal Principles”

Basic Appraisal Principles is designed as an introductory course for individuals preparing for a career as a valuation professional. The course provides the first 30 hours of qualifying pre-licensure education, which is commonly required by states for individuals seeking appraisal licensure.

The course uses experienced instructors to guide participants through introductory economic concepts. Participants learn the basic appraisal principles that can be used to build a solid foundation for an ethical and competent appraisal practice. Concepts such as highest and best use, the time value of money and the nature of value are explored through instructor-led discussion. Real-world type problems are introduced to aid participants in developing their problem-solving skills.

- **Calculators.** A financial calculator is required. The accepted model used in the course is the HP 12 C.
