Business Practices & Ethics Course Scope: If you are, or want to become, a member of the Appraisal Institute, this second course in the Appraisal Institute’s Standards of Professional Practice series is for you. You’ll learn how the organization’s Code of Professional Ethics can empower you to practice your profession in accordance with the Appraisal Institute’s guiding values and principles and why this is important to you as a practicing appraiser. Participants will become familiar with the definitions and canons of the Code of Professional Ethics and how the code relates to the *Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice* and the Appraisal Institute’s Certification Standard.
